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## HUMBLE, GENTLE, PATIENT AND TOLERANT

- Eph 4:1 Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called,
- Eph 4:2 with all <u>humility and</u> gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love,
- Eph 4:3 being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

#### **DEAL WITH YOUR ANGER**

- ph 4:26 BE ANGRY, AND yet DO NOT SIN; do not let the sun go down on your anger,
- Eph 4:27 and do not give the devil an opportunity.

#### **WATCH YOUR WORDS**

- Eph 4:29 <u>Let no unwholesome word</u> <u>proceed from your mouth</u>, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, so that it will give grace to those who hear.
- Eph 4:30 Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

#### **FORGIVENESS**

- Eph 4:31 Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice.
- Eph 4:32 <u>Be kind to one another,</u> tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

#### **ASK GOD?**

- Pray for God to reveal any unresolved resentments. Clear the road for healthy, loving communication. Don't avoid conflict, resolve it!!!
